Awards

The Lullingstone Trophy, including one year's free entry to The World Garden – awarded to the person with the most points in the show.

The Cactus at the Castle Award – awarded for the best cactus in the show.

The Cactus and Succulent Review Prize – awarded to the best succulent in the show.

The People's Award – awarded to the entrant of the plant receiving the most votes from the public.

The Castle Cup – awarded to the winner of Class 21 (Junior class).

Show Information and Rules

1. Entry into the Show constitutes acceptance of these rules.
2. All classes except Class 21 are open to any entrant.
3. The term 'succulent' is taken to exclude cacti.
4. Junior entrants are those aged 16 years or younger on the day of show.
5. Plants must be the property of the exhibitor, who may make up to two entries per class.
6. Points will be scored 5-3-2 for the top three entries in each class plus 1 point for a 'highly commended' entry and prize cards will also be awarded.
7. There is no entry fee and no prize monies will be awarded.
8. Entries by post, telephone or email must reach the Show Manager by Wednesday 11th September.
9. No entries will be accepted on the day of the show without the prior permission of the Show Manager.
10. No pot may contain more than one plant.
11. Size of pot is taken as its diameter across the top inside the rim. Square pots are measured along the top of one side inside the rim.
12. Exhibitors must follow Stewards' instructions and may not move other entries while staging their own.
13. An entry card must be placed name down with each exhibit.
14. The Judge(s) may withhold any award if, in their opinion, the standard does not merit it.
15. Any plant that in the opinion of the Judge or Show Manager is infected with pest or disease will be removed from the show and will not be eligible for awards.
16. Any protests must be received directly in writing by the Show Manager, not the Judge(s), no later than one hour after judging is concluded.
17. No exhibitor may remove exhibits before the show is declared closed without prior permission from the Show Manager.
18. Exhibitors will receive free entry to *Cactus at the Castle* and the Mexican Celebration Weekend on the day of the show.
19. All property including exhibits brought onto the Show site will be at the owner's risk. Whilst every care will be taken, Lullingstone Castle, Cactus at the Castle, their officials and staff will not accept any liability for loss or damage.
